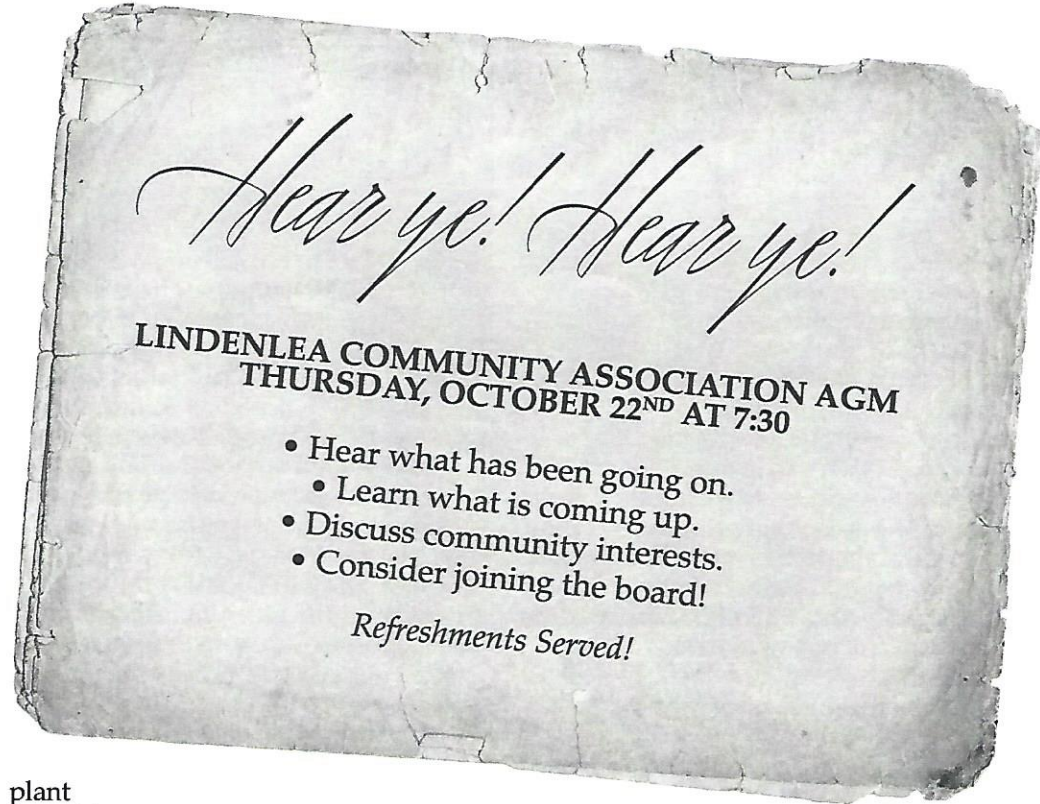




COMMUNITY GARDEN UPDATE

plant roots like garlic and onions to overwinter in the ground and harvest next year. Did you know that some seeds actually need to go through a season of freezing before they can sprout? This is a process called "stratification", and many northern plants like the cedar tree (used for medicinal healing teas) require this.

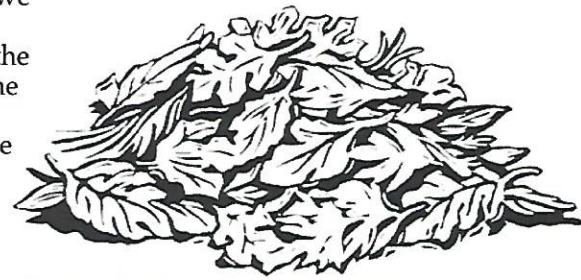
